Dear friends,

All of us are aware that our world is full of suffering, but this fact can become obscured by the illusion of safety that scientific progress and medical advances offer us. Yet, from time to time, the whole world is shocked into a collective consideration of the continuing reality of human weakness and mortality. The events of 9/11 and the Boxing Day Tsunami in 2001 were such events, and the current pandemic is another.

These events force us, sometimes against our will, to consider hard questions about God's intentions for our world. What is he doing, allowing this to happen? Why has Christ not yet returned to establish justice and peace?

Towards the end of *Suffering Life's Pain*, David Gooding and John Lennox offer some reflections on the purpose and value of suffering in the life of a believer.

According to Christ, position and responsibility in his coming kingdom will in part depend on a disciple's suffering here on earth (Mark 10:37–40). The greater the suffering, the greater the eventual position of responsibility. But we are not to go out of our way to seek suffering. God gives us all things freely to enjoy; and we are surely meant to enjoy life as much as we can. Nor are we called upon to understand everything and to be able to explain all the providences of God. The longest book in the Bible on the topic of suffering is the book of Job. Though Job initially felt that there was something extremely unfair about the amount of suffering he had to endure, in the end he was brought to see that the goal of suffering is to train us to trust both the love and the wisdom of God. God will always go beyond our ability to comprehend him. Our eternal peace of mind will arise from the deep-rooted conviction, learned by experience, that 'to those who love God, God works everything together for good, even to them who are called according to his purpose' (Rom 8:28).

Despite even the most difficult circumstances, it should strengthen our faith and hope when we remember that God is fully aware of our situation and continually engaged in working all things to fulfill his goal of making us like his Son.

Suffering Life's Pain is currently available as a free download on our website. We trust that it, and the other resources highlighted in this edition of Between Friends, will strengthen the faith of many in these days that are uncertain yet filled with gospel opportunity.


Translations

Spanish

We are almost ready to publish the first Myrtlefield House Spanish edition of *The Riches of Divine Wisdom*. At the time of writing, the first draft paperback copies have arrived at our office for review. If all goes according to plan, this book will be released on July 3rd, 2020.

Bulgarian/Hungarian

During the last year, we were contacted by believers from Bulgaria and Hungary who were interested in translating various *Myrtlefield Transcripts* into their respective languages. Translation work has now commenced in both countries.





German

In our last edition, we reported that the first book in The Quest series was being published by Christliche Verlagsgesellschaft (CV). They have now teamed up with the Institut für Glaube und Wissenschaft (IGUW) to publish the full series.

Portuguese

We have a long-standing relationship with A Verdade in Brazil. They have published many of our books through the years, with the most recent being *The Bible and Ethics*. A Verdade has printed 1,000 copies of this book for sale in Brazil and The Myrtlefield Trust has given a grant to print 2,000 additional copies for free distribution in Angola.

Italian

The translation of *The Riches of Divine Wisdom* into Italian is now underway. It will be co-published with Edizioni GBU and should be available later this year.

Czech

ALEF Křesťanské sbory are in the final stages of publishing *Christianity: Opium or Truth*? in Czech. This should be available this summer.

Quest Grant Project

In 2019 we began a project to provide 2,000 free sets (12,000 books) of *The Quest* series to various strategic partners. The total cost of production and distribution of these books has been sourced from a combination of funding bodies and private donations. We are providing grants to the following groups:

Langham Libraries - 361 sets

The Myrtlefield Trust is continuing to work with Langham Partnership through providing several hundred colleges in the majority world with high-quality Christian material for their libraries.

Langham Scholars - 189 sets

Langham Partnership's Scholars Programme provides book grants to several hundred PhD students. The 189 sets we provided will be distributed to select students in this programme who will most benefit from the material.

OPAL Trust - 100 sets

OPAL Trust distributes quality resources to Christians in the majority world. The Myrtlefield Trust has a history of supporting this work, and the present book grant supported groups in Kenya, Zambia and India.

OCCA - 400 sets

We have partnered with the Oxford Centre for Christian Apologetics to offer sets of *The Quest* to various groups, such as their Business Programme graduates, one-year programme OCCA graduates, and other core-supporters.

Global Journalism at NLA - 100 sets

These sets were provided to students completing a Masters in Global Journalism at NLA University in Norway. Passages from *The Quest* are being used to teach the course. Over several years, this grant will provide textbooks to students, many of whom would not have been able to afford them. The students come from a wide range of backgrounds and countries, including: Nepal, Bangladesh, South Korea, Iran, Georgia, Armenia, Ethiopia, Ghana, Uganda, Kosovo, Colombia and Norway.

Lausanne Europe Conference - 850 sets

This conference has been designed to equip believers from across Europe to better proclaim the gospel, impact society and shape European worldviews with Christian ideas. Originally scheduled to take place this autumn but delayed due to the pandemic. All being well, it will now be held in Wisla, Poland in November 2021. The leaders of the conference communicated that the provision of *The Quest* to attendees 'would be a marvellous resource to equip us all better in bearing witness to Jesus Christ and all his teaching in the realm of European worldviews and ideas'. We have granted a full set for each attendee.
